

The Road to Lavender reaches a major milestone

Fans of the e-book version of D.P. Benjamin's debut mystery novel have logged 23,749 pages read. As Book One of the author's Four Corners Mystery Series, it remains his most popular work of fiction.





Ann Boelter is a Western Colorado author who regularly appears in book shows sponsored by Elevation Press. Her debut historical romance novel, NENA, is Book One of the Viking Treasure Huntress Series. It topped the Amazon charts as a #1 Bestseller in the US, Canada, Australia and the UK. Awarded a Gold Medal in the Readers' Favorite International Book Awards in 2019, it has also been honored with an indieBRAG Medallion, and was recently voted Top 4 "Best Viking Romances" on Goodreads. The second book in the series, FIONA, is garnering similar attention.

According to Ann's website: "The books in this series center around the current captain of the mysterious Viking longship, the Treasure Huntress. At the end of each story, the next captain is revealed from the supporting characters. Each novel is set in a new location and is its own unique story, driven by the captain's personality, ambitions, and desires.
